

Holy Trinity Church – “The Parish”

Grade One listed building, presently on the Heritage At Risk Register.

Important Features

Ilfracombe’s oldest building – the tower dates to pre-conquest times – a place of safety!

14th century (or earlier) pillars.

Exceptional 15th century ceilings with carved bosses.

Fine 19th century carved work by local women

Elizabethan pulpit and other furnishings

11th century font

Mediaeval Carvings – a unique set of 28 corbels of mythological beasts c1321

Fine collection of mid-19th century stained glass by important manufacturers. Two Kempe windows.

Good memorials to local worthies, especially naval and military.
