**Appendix 2 – Proposal to create a transport recommendation to One Ilfracombe**

1. Add ‘transport’ to all themes: section 6. Programme-wide links and cross-cutting items
2. All themes to highlight any transport funding bids (even if unsuccessful)
3. Store all related evidence centrally to share across themes to continually build a case for change (starting with Cllr Terry Elliot’s report)
4. Political lobbying: request a 2-way feedback loop with DCC / NDDC and MP Ian Roome to apply political pressure, share evidence of need and request responses
5. Partnership: request a 2-way feedback loop with OND/NDF
